In addition, the Development Director will assist the Executive Director in the creation and execution of long-term fundraising strategies including capital campaigns, endowment campaigns, and a planned giving program in accordance with the Museum's mission. This is a full-time, exempt position. Flexible work schedule or part-time option may be possible for qualified candidates.

Responsibilities:

- Develop strategies and coordinate all annual fundraising activities to achieve museum goals, including but not limited to direct response efforts, special events, corporate partnerships/sponsorships and leadership annual giving
- Support Executive Director and Board in major donor and prospect contacts; ensure alignment and coordination between annual fundraising efforts and capital campaign
- Actively seek and secure new corporate/foundation/individual funding sources and maintain relationships with current/past donors (i.e. personal visits, articulate correspondence, and timely gift acknowledgements)
- Develop and manage the annual fundraising plan and budget.
- Deepen and broaden the stakeholders involved with the Museum through intentional cultivation and stewardship efforts
- Manage software systems related to fundraising and oversee staff responsible for data entry and gift processing
- Develop and track proposals and reports for all foundation and corporate fundraising.
- Provide progress reports to the Executive Director
- Maintain close working relationships with the Explore More Board, Staff, and Capital Campaign Team in pursuit of private and public sector funding for the museum
- Serve as staff liaison, providing direction and oversight to the Development Committee of the board
- Manage additional volunteer committees as needed to support annual fundraising efforts, i.e. special events committees
- Collaborate with staff to coordinate marketing, volunteer management, and community outreach efforts that impact development initiatives
