Students will gain practical experience teaching in the museum setting while also learning operating procedures and best practices required to run a successful children's museum.

- Must be a college student or recent graduate with preferred concentration in education and a focus in one of the following areas: early childhood, elementary education, science or art education*
- Commitment and enthusiasm for the museum's hands-on, educational mission
- Strong interpersonal skills
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills
- Experience working with children and families
- A self-starter with strong desire to learn
- Ability to work independently and as a team member
- Proficient in Microsoft Office (Word, PowerPoint, Excel)

Responsibilities:

- Actively assists museum staff in conducting and supervising Explorer Camps including classroom set-up/clean-up, preparation of materials, interacting with and directly supervising students
- Plans and implements weekly museum programs ensuring that they are developmentally appropriate, hands-on and accessible for a wide range of abilities
- Assists with program administration (class rosters, registration forms, etc.)
- Assists museum staff and volunteers with direct supervision and maintenance of exhibit areas
