Key responsibilities:

- Tracking inventory and prepping activity stations
- Serving as an ambassador for making
- Proposing and preparing new activities
- Answering, or researching the answers to questions that arise
- Assisting or facilitating workshops and trainings on specialized knowledge and skill areas
